Entry in this show, and lodging at Hotel Blackfoot using the club's booking, shall constitute an acknowledgement by and consent of the exhibitor to these procedures.

Rates: \$129.00 per night plus taxes for single or double occupancy. The pet fee has been waived for our event in lieu of

signing the TICA Hotel Policy Agreement.

Rooms have one queen bed plus sofa, or two queen beds. All rooms have a mini fridge, safe, and complimentary high speed and wireless internet access. Rooms with 2 beds are very limited. Book as soon as possible.

Rate includes a breakfast at Green's Restaurant for two people per room.

Parking is free.

All public areas are smoke free and vape free. Please do not use electric cigarettes.

Exhibitors must reserve directly with the hotel by phone and give the group name Calgary Cat Association or Calgary Cat Show. The room block at this rate has been reserved until March 31, 2023. After this date, if available, rooms may be booked at prevailing rates.

Please make every effort to leave your room in the condition it was found, if not better. **Be sure to confine spraying males and females** to a tent or the bathroom. TICA Hotel Room Inspection Procedures will be enforced and can be viewed at: http://tica.org/members/forms/eo/hotel_room_policy.pdf

Show rules require that a cat's claws be clipped both front and back. Please do this before arriving at the hotel. Hotel room furniture is expensive to replace/repair. Any damage done to any hotel room will be the responsibility of the exhibitor and not the Calgary Cat Association or the Kitties 'n Blooms Show organizing committee.

Hotel Blackfoot offers a Sedan Service to and from the airport for a flat fee of \$43.00 for up to three (3) people in the sedan. Arrangements must be made with Hotel Blackfoot directly.

<u>Show Hall</u> – The Joseph Kryczka Arena at Southland Leisure Centre, 2000 Southland Drive SW Calgary AB. There is plenty of free parking. The ice will be taken out of the arena only five (5) days before the show, therefore it may be chilly. Dress in layers to be comfortable.

<u>Show Hours</u> – Saturday the doors will open at 7:30 AM. Household Pet classification will begin at 8:30 AM Saturday and judging will start at 9:30 AM. Sunday judging will begin at 9:00 AM. Entries not present at the start of judging will be marked absent. Please plan to be at the show hall during show hours. No cat will be allowed to leave the show hall without permission of the Show Manager.

<u>Health</u> – This is a non-vetted show. Every cat that enters the show must confirm to normally accepted health requirements and be up-to-date on its vaccinations. Proof of vaccination may be requested, please have certificates on hand. Cats from households with contagious or infectious diseases within the last 21 days prior to the show are ineligible for entry. **Cats with suspected contagious or infectious illness or with parasites will be removed from the show hall.** Cats over 3 months of age entering Canada must show proof of current Rabies vaccination, if requested to do so by Canada Customs and the Canada Food Inspection Agency (CFIA). Customs agents and the CFIA do not require a Health Certificate, but if the cat is traveling into Canada by air, the commercial airline may require an International Health Certificate. Contact your airline for more information on their requirements.

<u>Show Rules</u> – TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering, exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and the Show Committee. Official show rules, registration information and forms may be obtained from <u>TICA</u>, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551 or viewed on their website at <u>www.tica.org</u>

Closing Dates, Payment and Fees

- By entering the show, you agree to pay all fees whether you attend the show or not.
- All entries must be <u>received</u>, by mail, phone or email. Closing will be when all spaces are filled, or April 9/23. No Late Pages Firm. To enter the show, the entry clerk requires a completed summary sheet, and a completed entry form for every cat or kitten you are bringing, and payment for the amount owed. Entry into the show will be confirmed via email.
- All entries must be accompanied by a payment. Payment can be made via Interac Money
 <u>Transfer</u> or <u>PayPal</u> payable to <u>calcatvar@yahoo.ca</u>. Canadian residents are encouraged to please use interact
 money transfer to help keep club costs down. If using PayPal, please include an additional \$5.00 to cover PayPal
 fees. Cats will not be benched unless all fees are paid. Postdated cheques cannot be accepted.
- Cats co-owned by members of two different households are eligible for the "second entry", "third entry" and "fourth and subsequent entries" discount <u>only</u> if a <u>photocopy</u> of the cat's TICA registration accompanies the cat's entry. The registration must show the names of both co-owners.
- \$50.00 will be added to your entry fees for any cheque returned for any reason.
- See the Summary Sheet for information on fees.

Show Catalogues – An electronic copy of the exhibitor show catalogue is FREE and will be emailed to each exhibitor by 9:00 PM on the Thursday before the show. Printed show catalogues can be purchased at a cost of \$10.00 and must be preordered and requested on your summary sheet. No catalogues will be available for sale at the show hall. The show committee accepts no responsibility for catalogue errors due to illegibility or mistakes on the entry form. Please verify your confirmations.

<u>Registration</u> - All cats shown in Kitten, Championship, and Alter classes must be **TICA** registered or must provide proof of eligibility for registration to compete. Contact the Entry Clerk for more information on how to enter your cats. Preliminary & Advanced New Breeds and New Traits **must** be **TICA** registered to enter and compete.

<u>Household Pets</u> – Household pets are very welcome at this show! Declawed pets are okay at TICA shows. This is due to the number of HHPs that are rescue cats and may have already been declawed at the time of rescue.

Household Pets over 8 months of age must be altered (neutered or spayed). Household Pets from 4 to 8 months old are entered in the Household Pet Kitten class and can be either altered or unaltered.

Household Pets are judged according to hair length (longhair or shorthair) and according to colour and division. Please describe your cat's colour and coat pattern accurately and note whether it is longhair (LH) or shorthair (SH) on your entry form. Please telephone the entry clerk if you are not sure how to describe your cat's colour and coat pattern or if you have any questions about how to complete the entry form. Sending an email photo of your cat will assist the Entry Clerk in determining your cat's colour and pattern.

<u>Kittens</u> – Kittens must be four calendar months old (not sixteen weeks of age) to compete in the show. For this show, kittens must be born on or before **December 22, 2022**. Cats over 3 months of age entering Canada must show proof of current Rabies vaccination, if requested to do so by Canada Customs and the Canada Food Inspection Agency (CFIA). Customs agents and the CFIA do not require a Health Certificate, but if the cat is traveling into Canada by air, the commercial airline may require an International Health Certificate. Contact your airline for more information on their requirements.

<u>Cat Food and Litter</u> – Cat litter will be provided in the show hall. Bring your own litter pans, cat food, and dishes. Litter must be securely bagged and disposed in marked containers.

Benching – The first entry receives a double space (21"x45"). A second entry will be placed with the first entry in the double space. Additional double cages may be available on special request. One chair will be provided per double cage space. The top, floor, sides and back of the cage must be covered. Special benching requests made on the Summary Sheet will be honoured as much as possible. No benching assignments may be changed without permission of the Show Manager or Entry Clerk. If you are using a personal cage, please ensure it fits in the 21X45" space.

Grooming Space - Please indicate on the Summary Sheet if you would be interested in a space.

<u>Rosettes</u> - Each exhibitor will receive one rosette for every cat entered in competition. The rosettes will be hung on cages in the benching area. Final awards will be recognized with plaquettes given by the judge to the exhibitor for placement on the cat's rosette.

Exhibition/For Sale - This is available to exhibitors with competing entries only.

Ring Clerks and Stewards – If you would like to clerk, please indicate this on the Summary Sheet. Clerks will receive lunch, plus a \$40.00 honoraria for each day clerked. They will be paid after clerking; please do not deduct clerking honoraria from your Entry Fee. Please indicate on the Summary Sheet is you have a child who would like to Steward. Stewards will receive a \$20.00 honoraria for each ring per day, plus lunch.

<u>Spectators, Friends and Family</u> – The Show Hall is very large and spectators are welcome. Spectator fees: Adults (12+) \$10.00, Children (6-11) and Seniors \$5.00

<u>Sponsorship</u> – Please consider sponsoring a judge or rings. See the Summary Sheet for information on our new Sponsorship fee schedule.
