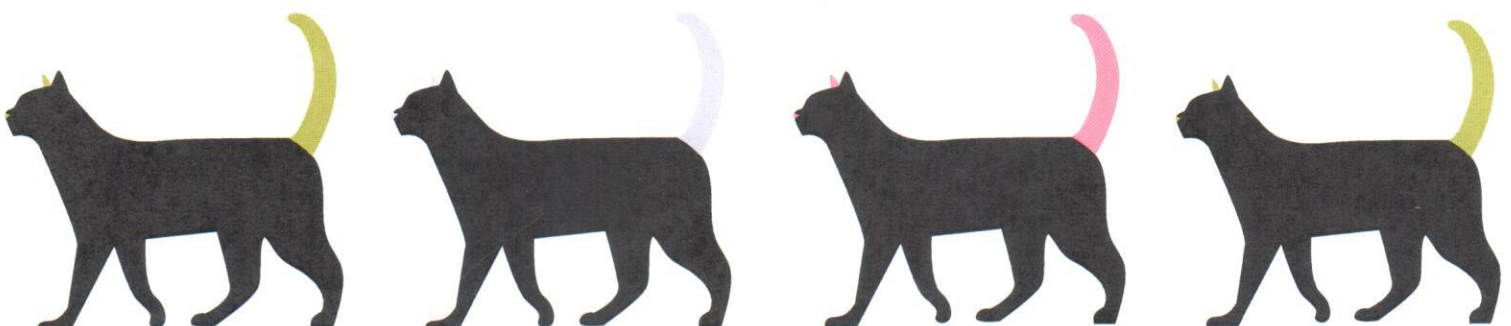

### **COVID STATEMENT**

As of **November 15, 2021** Alberta requires patrons 12 years and over to show proof of vaccination. The **only valid proof of vaccination** for Alberta residents is the **QR code**. **Out of province visitors** must show their provincially recognized vaccine record with full name and dates of vaccinations, and a piece of personal identification. **International visitors** must show their proof of vaccination document they used when entering Canada, and a piece of personal identification.

**Masks** must be worn at all times unless actively eating or drinking.

Hotel Blackfoot will issue a wristband to guests and exhibitors when appropriate records are provided. These bands must remain on while attending the show or using hotel facilities.

### **Show Hotel – TICA Hotel Procedures will be in effect for this show.**

Official show hotel: **Hotel Blackfoot, 5940 Blackfoot Trail SE Calgary, AB.**

The Calgary Cat Association has elected to use the **TICA Hotel Room Inspection Procedures** for exhibitors who stay at Hotel Blackfoot using the club's booking. Entry in this show, and lodging at Hotel Blackfoot using the club's booking, shall constitute an acknowledgement by and consent of the exhibitor to these procedures.

Rates: \$119.00 per night plus taxes for single or double occupancy. The pet fee has been waived for our event in lieu of signing the TICA Hotel Policy Agreement.

Rooms have one queen bed plus sofa, or two queen beds. All rooms have a mini fridge, safe, and complimentary high speed and wireless internet access.

Rate includes a breakfast at Green's Restaurant for two people per room.

Parking is free.

All public areas are smoke free and vape free. Please do not use electric cigarettes.

Exhibitors must reserve directly with the hotel by phone and give the group name Calgary Cat Association or Calgary Cat Show. The room block at this rate has been reserved until March 31, 2022. After this date, if available, rooms may be booked at prevailing rates.

Please make every effort to leave your room in the condition it was found, if not better. **Be sure to confine spraying males and females** to a tent or the bathroom. TICA Hotel Room Inspection Procedures will be enforced and can be viewed at: [http://tica.org/members/forms/eo/hotel\\_room\\_policy.pdf](http://tica.org/members/forms/eo/hotel_room_policy.pdf)

Show rules require that a cat's claws be clipped both front and back. Please do this before arriving at the hotel. Hotel room furniture is expensive to replace/repair. Any damage done to any hotel room will be the responsibility of the exhibitor and not the Calgary Cat Association or the Kitties 'n Blooms Show organizing committee.

**Transportation** - Hotel Blackfoot offers a Sedan Service to and from the airport for a flat fee of \$43.00 for up to three (3) people in the sedan. Arrangements must be made with Hotel Blackfoot directly.

**Show Hall** – The show will be held in the Ballroom at the show hotel. There is ample free parking.

**Show Hours** – Saturday the doors will open at 8:00 AM. Household Pet classification will begin at 9:00 AM Saturday and judging will start at 9:30 AM. Sunday judging will begin at 9:00 AM. Entries not present at the start of judging will be marked absent. Please plan to be at the show hall during show hours. No cat will be allowed to leave the show hall without permission of the Show Manager.

**Health** – This is a non-vetted show. Every cat that enters the show must confirm to normally accepted health requirements and be up-to-date on its vaccinations. Proof of vaccination may be requested, please have certificates on hand. Cats from households with contagious or infectious diseases within the last 21 days prior to the show are ineligible for entry. **Cats with suspected contagious or infectious illness or with parasites will be removed from the show hall.** Cats over 3 months of age entering Canada must show proof of current Rabies vaccination, if requested to do so by Canada Customs and the Canada Food Inspection Agency (CFIA). Customs agents and the CFIA do not require a Health Certificate, but if the cat is traveling into



Canada by air, the commercial airline may require an International Health Certificate. Contact your airline for more information on their requirements.

**Show Rules** – TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering, exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and the Show Committee. Official show rules, registration information and forms may be obtained from TICA, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551 or viewed on their website at [www.tica.org](http://www.tica.org)

### **Closing Dates, Payment and Fees**

- By entering the show, you agree to pay all fees whether you attend the show or not.
- All entries must be received, by mail, phone or email. Closing will be when all spaces are filled, or March 28/22. **No Late Pages – Firm.** To enter the show, the entry clerk requires a completed summary sheet, and a completed entry form for every cat or kitten you are bringing, and **payment** for the amount owed. Entry into the show will be confirmed via email.
- All entries must be accompanied by a cheque or money order. Payment can also be made via Interac Email Money Transfer or PayPal payable to [calcatvar@yahoo.ca](mailto:calcatvar@yahoo.ca). **Canadian residents are encouraged to please use interact mail transfer to help keep club costs down.** If using PayPal, please designate payment as a gift, rather than payment for services. Cats will not be benched unless all fees are paid. Postdated cheques cannot be accepted.
- Cats co-owned by members of two different households are eligible for the “second entry”, “third entry” and “fourth and subsequent entries” discount only if a photocopy of the cat’s TICA registration accompanies the cat’s entry. The registration must show the names of both co-owners.
- No single day entries will be available.
- \$50.00 will be added to your entry fees for any cheque returned for any reason.
- See the Summary Sheet for information on fees.

**Show Catalogues** – One show catalogue is included free with your first entry. Additional catalogues must be ordered on your summary sheet for \$10.00 each. No catalogues will be available for sale at the show hall. The show committee accepts no responsibility for catalogue errors due to illegibility or mistakes on the entry form. Please verify your confirmations.

**Registration** - All cats shown in Kitten, Championship, and Alter classes must be **TICA** registered or must provide proof of eligibility for registration to compete. Contact the Entry Clerk for more information on how to enter your cats. Preliminary & Advanced New Breeds and New Traits must be **TICA** registered to enter and compete.

**Household Pets** – Household pets are very welcome at this show! Declawed pets are OK at TICA shows. This is due to the number of HHPs that are rescue cats and may have already been declawed at the time of rescue.

Household Pets over 8 months of age must be altered (neutered or spayed). Household Pets from 4 to 8 months old are entered in the Household Pet Kitten class and can be either altered or unaltered.

Household Pets are judged according to hair length (longhair or shorthair) and according to colour and division. Please describe your cat’s colour and coat pattern accurately and note whether it is longhair (LH) or shorthair (SH) on your entry form. Please telephone the entry clerk if you are not sure how to describe your cat’s colour and coat pattern or if you have any questions about how to complete the entry form. Sending an email photo of your cat will assist the Entry Clerk in determining your cat’s colour and pattern.

**Kittens** – Kittens must be four calendar months old (not sixteen weeks of age) to compete in the show. For this show, kittens must be born on or before December 9, 2021. Cats over 3 months of age entering Canada must show proof of current Rabies vaccination, if requested to do so by Canada Customs and the Canada Food Inspection Agency (CFIA). Customs agents and the CFIA do not require a Health Certificate, but if the cat is traveling into Canada by air, the commercial airline may require an International Health Certificate. Contact your airline for more information on their requirements.

**Cat Food and Litter** – Cat litter will be provided in the show hall. Bring your own litter pans, cat food, and dishes. Litter must be securely bagged and disposed in marked containers.

**Benching** – The first entry receives a double space (21"x21"x45"). A second entry will be placed with the first entry in the double space. Additional double cages may be available on special request. Please contact the Entry Clerk regarding this. One chair will be provided per double cage space. The top, floor, sides and back of the cage must be covered. Special benching requests made on the Summary Sheet will be honoured as much as possible. No benching assignments may be changed without permission of the Show Manager.

**Grooming Space** - Due to limited space, grooming spaces **will not** be available. Please indicate on the Summary Sheet if you would be interested in being on the wait list, should space become available.

**Rosettes** - Each exhibitor will receive one rosette for every cat entered in competition. The rosettes will be hung on cages in the benching area. Final awards will be recognized with plaquettes given by the judge to the exhibitor for placement on the cat's rosette.

**Exhibition/For Sale** – Due to limited space, there **WILL NOT** be any space available for exhibition or sale.

**Ring Clerks and Stewards** – If you would like to clerk, please indicate this on the Summary Sheet. Clerks will receive lunch, plus a \$40.00 honoraria for each day clerked. They will be paid after clerking; please do not deduct clerking honoraria from your Entry Fee. Please indicate on the Summary Sheet if you have a child who would like to Steward. Stewards will receive a \$20.00 honoraria for each ring per day, plus lunch.

**Spectators, Friends and Family** – The Show Hall is very small. No spectators or vendors will be in the show hall. Each space will be allotted 2 chairs only.

**Sponsorship** – Please consider sponsoring a judge or rings. See the Summary Sheet for information on our new Sponsorship fee schedule.

**Liability** – The Calgary Cat Association, its individual members, The Hotel Blackfoot, and TICA will **NOT** be held responsible for injury, illness, loss or damage to cats, exhibitors, or other persons attending the show; nor any property belonging to exhibitors or other persons.
